








**DIRECTORS' RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS
FOR COMPANIES / CORPORATIONS
FOR EACH CANADIAN JURISDICTION**

Jurisdiction	Directors' residency requirements
Federal (Canada) 	Yes At least twenty-five per cent of the directors of a corporation must be resident Canadians. However, if a corporation has less than four directors, at least one director must be a resident Canadian.
Alberta 	Yes At least 1/4 of the directors of a corporation must be resident Canadians.
British-Columbia 	No requirement
Prince Edward Island 	No requirement
Ontario 	Yes At least 25 per cent of the directors of a corporation other than a non-resident corporation shall be resident Canadians, but where a corporation has less than four directors, at least one director shall be a resident Canadian.
Manitoba 	Yes At least 25% of a corporation's directors must be residents of Canada. If a corporation's board is comprised of three or fewer directors, one of them must be a resident of Canada.
New Brunswick 	No requirement

<p>Nunavut</p> 	<p>No requirement</p>
<p>Quebec</p> 	<p>No requirement*</p> <p>*Not in the actual Companies Act and not in the future new Business Corporations Act in Quebec.</p>
<p>Saskatchewan</p> 	<p>Yes</p> <p>At least 25% of the directors of a corporation must be resident Canadians, but if a corporation has fewer than four directors, at least one director must be a resident Canadian.</p>
<p>Newfoundland/Labrador</p> 	<p>At least 25% of the directors of a corporation shall be resident Canadians*. (*does not apply to a body corporate that earns no income in Canada).</p>
<p>Northwest Territories</p> 	<p>No requirement</p>
<p>Yukon</p> 	<p>No requirement</p>
